City Of Georgetown Local Condition Statement Outdoor Burning Ban

April 23, 2009

This is a local conditions statement with official information from the City of Georgetown.

Effective at 1:30 PM today, Fire Chief Joseph K. Tanner has issued a ban on any outdoor burning within the City Limits of Georgetown.

The order coincides with a similar order issued by the State Forester for the unincorporated areas of the state.

Atmospheric conditions are, again today, very favorable for rapid spread of any fire. Low relative humidity and dry conditions continue to exist with very little change expected over the next couple of days.

The fire department is in a high state of readiness in anticipation of the fire threat.

Open burning should be reported immediately to the Georgetown County Central Dispatch Center by dialing 911.

The ban on burning in the City will remain in effect until further notice.
