City Of Georgetown Local Statement Replacement of CSX Fraser Street Crossing March 20, 2009

This is official information from the City of Georgetown issued by Mayor Lynn Wood Wilson's Office.

CSX Railroad has scheduled Tuesday March 24 to replace the Fraser Street crossing. The work will completely block Fraser Street at Front Street.

In order to accommodate traffic the Police Department has established a detour around the intersection.

All Southbound traffic will use Merriman Road to move around the blockage. Southbound Highway 17 traffic will cross through five points and turn right on to Highway 521 or Highmarket street. At the next light, Merriman Road, traffic will turn left and take Merriman road to Bourne street. Turn left and proceed through two stop signs to Highway 17.

All Northbound traffic will use Hazard Street. At Front Street turn left, proceed one block to Hazard and turn right.

The detour will remain in place until the crossing is opened to traffic by CSX.

As with all detours traffic may become heavy at times. It's important to use a little extra caution and drive defensively. Plan to give yourself extra time to reach your destination. Some intersections may be manned with Police Officers. If this is the case pay attention to the officer's directions.
