City Of Georgetown Local Condition Statement Tropical Storm Ida

November 10, 2009 9:00 AM

This is a local conditions statement with official information from the City of Georgetown.

The City of Georgetown is monitoring a period of heavy rainfall expected to continue through Wednesday evening. According to forecasts from the National Weather Service Office in Wilmington, rainfall could total between 3 and 6 inches through the period.

Heavy showers will cause ponding of water on streets and roadways. Flooding of low lying and flood prone areas can be expected, especially during high tide.

High tide in the harbor is expected at 3:35 PM today, 4:18 AM and 4:35 PM Wednesday.

Motorists are urged to avoid flooded streets and roadways as it is likely your vehicle will stall. Motorists are also cautioned to not drive through or beyond barricades.
