City of Georgetown Local Condition Weather Statement Remnants of Hurricane/Tropical Storm Ida

Issued: November 12, 2009 6:00 AM

This is official information from the City of Georgetown.

The City of Georgetown documented the following information from the storm:

Rainfall at Fire Station One, 1405 Prince Street, Tuesday November 10 was 0.66 inches; Wednesday November 11 was 2.56 inches for a storm total of 3.22 inches. The highest wind velocity was recorded on Wednesday at 29 mph.

Rainfall at Fire Station Two, 2014 South Island Road, Tuesday November 10 was 1.11 inches; Wednesday November 11 was 3.78 inches for a storm total of 4.89 inches. The highest wind velocity was recorded on Wednesday at 26 mph.

U.S. Highway 17 was closed for an hour and a half, due to flooding, from Church Street to Front Street from 8:15 AM to 9:45 AM. High tide occurred at 4:35 PM without incident.
