Helicopter Landing Zone Training

In addition to the several hundred hours of training this month, personnel participated in training to set up and maintain landing zones for medical evacuation helicopters. The training includes ensuring the LZ is clear of foreign objects and debris, potential obstacles are identified, clear communications between the pilot and the LZ officer and maintaining securing until the aircraft is clear of the LZ.

All three shifts participated in the training provided by a new medical flight company, Life Care, based out of Conway.

Life Care can fly directly to an accident scene if necessary.
