Training this month emphasized engine company operations in support of aerial operations. This particular drill was conducted during the Training Achievement Award program and involve a timed exercise of placing aerial streams into operation under the support of an engine company.

This type of training exercises skills that are seldom used in emergency situations as it is rare to need aerial water streams.

All three shifts ironed out some rough areas and were able to complete the drill without difficulty.
